The author could formulate the problem more clearly, for example through the concern about the involvement of young people in the smuggling of goods and the further high proportion of participation in crime, ruined lives, etc. Also formulate the purpose and research questions. Keywords must be added.</p> <p>4- Structure - Add a purpose to the Introduction of the article. Change the repetition of the description in the Methodology chapter and, if necessary, add clarification to the introduction. (<i>Badagry is a town ..</i>)</p> <p>The methodology should explain, how the categories were created and some authors (sources) according to which the given analysis method is used.</p> <p>When presenting the results, it would help to present the results based on research questions. There is no association with referenced sources in the discussion, it must be added.</p> <p>The conclusion and recommendations can be combined into one subsection.</p> <p>5- Needs correction, there is substance.</p> <p>6- References are appropriate</p>
