<p>Optional/General comments</p>	<p>This article is very useful for the medical community and it is very important to insist on this issue because it is vitally important to know about this problem, because it is a disease that is difficult to diagnose and requires urgent treatment measures, and it is very important to detect the problem quickly because otherwise failure to start antibiotic treatment on time, complications can lead to the death of the patient</p> <p>Listeria monocytogenes meningitis is a rare disease that occurs after consumption of contaminated food.</p> <p>Listeria monocytogenes meningitis is a serious disease, with high mortality (the highest among the bacterial species that cause meningitis) and although it is rare, it represents the third cause of bacterial meningitis (preceded by Streptococcus pneumoniae and Neisseria meningitidis respectively), being The most affected population is newborns, pregnant women, the elderly and immunocompromised patients.</p> <p>Empirical antibiotic treatment should be started as early as possible when suspected, given the high risk of mortality.</p> <p>The authors must be congratulated for addressing this issue, which should be published due to the importance of making it known to all healthcare agents so that they can take it into account and initiate treatment urgently to avoid unwanted outcomes.</p>
