The article is devoted to the actual problem of protection against computer viruses. However, the research materials practically don't contain new results, which reduces the potential interest of readers (see comments below).</p> <p>2. The article's title does not fully correspond to its content, as it is difficult to call the conducted research systematic. This is instead a review of the already known results of studying the problems of computer viruses.</p> <p>3. The abstract corresponds to the content of the article.</p> <p>4. The article is structured, but the content of individual sections does not correspond to their title, in particular, Section 4.</p> <p>5. From a scientific point of view, the article doesn't contain new information. It only repeats generally known results, including a description of the main threats of computer viruses, methods of their identification, and recommendations for protection against damage by a computer virus. Section "1. INTRODUCTION" declares task "3. To provide well defined steps on how to protect and prevent illegal stealing of confidential data such as credit card number, account password, etc", but the paper does not contain any related information. Section "4. RESULTS AND DISCUSSION" contains only the results of interviews. However, the results are presented generally without specifying the respondents' answers. The author(s) should emphasize the practical utility of this survey in the context of the article's purpose. It is also worth noting that the sample size is 5 people. This is not enough to form statistically significant conclusions. This section does not contain the author's contribution to the discussion of the results but only repeats the conclusions drawn earlier, reflected by the corresponding citations. Subsection "3.2.2 Secondary Research Method" declares the use of secondary data, in particular, the analysis of publications on the subject of computer viruses. However, it does not emphasize the purpose for which this data is used.</p> <p>6. A significant part of the information sources was published more than ten years ago and, therefore, can't be considered current. The research information base should be significantly updated.</p>
