DIs and DHIs are hydrophobic metabolites that can be retained by C18 and recovered by 80% methanol.</p> <p><b>Reference 40 is repeated with same concept in 2 places which can be removed</b></p> <p><b>Cancer is caused by wound unhealing dur to the collapse of chemo-surveillance. The concept of cancer as wound unhealing was first introduced by the great German scientist Virchow in the 19<sup>th</sup> century [597.</b> Author can check and paraphrase the concept</p>
