Compulsory REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Probably, the author(s) may state the strand of radical feminism they are using as a framework for the paper—radical-libertarian feminism or radical-cultural feminism? Author(s) should strengthen the discussion of radical feminists' views on sexual victimization. Hana's experience in Shaarawi's <i>Niqabi Ninja</i> would seem to suggest she suffers from sex discrimination in all of its ramifications, including but not limited to sexual harassment. Hana is a victim of sexual assault, sexual harassment, sexual misconduct, and sexual abuse. Author(s) should make these possibilities clear in the paper. The overreliance of sexual harassment alone makes the discussion a bit skewed. Shaarawi's depiction of Hana on pages 19 and 23 indicates that sexual victimization is associated with depressive symptoms, including paranoia symptoms. Author(s) could acknowledge this in the discussion. Shaarawi refers to male figures in London as well. Author(s) should not limit their analysis to Egyptian male-folk only. Perhaps a reference to some literature, contemporary to Shaarawi's book, could cast more light on the writings of "militant feminism." Author(s) should indicate how the qualitative content analysis technique informed the research question, units for categorization, analytical criteria, analysis, and results.
