Break up your paragraphs into smaller, useful units; ➤ The 1st paragraph should contain the general background of the topic; ➤ The 2nd and 3rd paragraphs should discuss previous works related to the topic; ➤ The last paragraph should Point out issues that are being addressed about the problem and the purpose of the present work. ❖ Materials and Methods: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ You should also speak about the materials used, studied variables and data collection, statistical analysis, in order to make this section more attractive and informative. ➤ You should also bring back the ideas of the clinical observation from the results section to materials and methods section. ➤ You should organize this section with subheading in order to make it more attractive. ❖ Results <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Make sure your graphs and tables can speak for themselves; ➤ The Results section should contain only results, no discussion; ➤ You should organize this section with subheading and do not repeat in words everything
