<p><b>Optional/General</b> comments</p>	The effect of migration on the family unit is, without a doubt, diverse and multidimensional. In this sense, the research presented is of great importance. However, the study design does not allow obtaining appropriate information. It is neither a case study (which would have been much more enriching, analysing all the aspects involved for a specific family unit), nor is it working with an adequate sample (of the 20 students surveyed, the majority declared themselves "non-migrants").
