<p>Optional/General comments</p>	<p>Introduction</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introduction needs to be revised and should be well organized • The traditional uses and reported activities of Aloe vera are required to be written as separate paragraphs with updated references avoiding repetition of words • The type and structure of leukocytes is required to be added briefly • The same reference should not be used repeatedly (e.g. Singh, 2002) • The aims and objectives of the study are needed to be clearly mentioned <p>Results:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The result section needs to be revised • A heading of sub-acute toxicity has been mentioned in this section, it is better to relate this term in the title as well • In the results of red blood cells, "it is mentioned that the RBC counts decreased until the termination of the administration". Have the authors checked the RBC count after 14 days. If yes, then the results may be added in the table for the justification of this statement • The results are needed to be re-checked especially for the statistical analysis of Tables 4, 6, 7 & 8 • The results of leukocytes may be added/merged as one table <p>Discussion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discussion needs to be ore elaborative • The proposed mechanism of Aloe vera and its constituents can be written in first paragraph • Each parameter needs to be discussed individually as well as the clinical relevance of each parameter may be added
