The manuscript addresses the management of anterior crossbite in the mixed dentition period, using the specific 2x4 appliance. This topic is highly relevant to the scientific community as early intervention in malocclusions during the mixed dentition phase can have a positive impact on growth and occlusal development.</p> <p>2. The title, "WATCH THEM YOUNG – TEACH THEM GROW," appears more like a quote or slogan than a descriptive title. A more suitable alternative could be: "Managing Developing Anterior Crossbite in Mixed Dentition with the Versatile 2x4 Appliance."</p> <p>3. The abstract offers a good overview of the case report, emphasizing the significance of early intervention in anterior crossbite and mentioning the use of the 2x4 appliance. However, it would be beneficial to include specific treatment results or outcomes in the abstract.</p> <p>4. The manuscript's subsections, covering introduction, case description, discussion, and conclusion, seem appropriate, although a comprehensive evaluation of the overall structure requires access to the full content.</p> <p>5. Based on the abstract information, the manuscript appears scientifically sound in its approach to managing anterior crossbite using the 2x4 appliance.</p> <p>7. The references cited in the abstract indicate that the authors have utilized relevant sources from the fields of orthodontics and pediatric dentistry.</p>
