Also, one cannot conduct a case-control study without indicating odd ratios (Likelihood) since it establishes cause and effect)</p> <p>2. The statement on line 5 of the discussion should be at the methods section.</p> <p>3. Findings from the table 4 are contrary to the description under section 3.6</p> <p>4. There is no relationship between table 3 and ADHD contrary to the heading.</p> <p>5. <i>3.3 – Type of substance used by the patients---Please check line 3.</i></p> <p>6. Table 1. If the data is skewed, then use median otherwise, if uniformly distributed, then use the mean there is no need presenting both please.</p> <p>7. At the methods section: Was the questionnaire standardised if yes can you mention specifically eg SCID ETC. If the questionnaire were developed by the researchers using the DSM 5, then there is a need to indicate the psychometric properties of the tool.</p> <p>8. Introduction:1. The part on TC doesn't have any particular link with the background it may be deleted. 2. The gap identified is not the objective of this study. 3.Let the full name come before the acronym. 4. If ADHD is commonly associated with substance use disorder, why use case control? Case-control studies are used for rare conditions or conditions with very low prevalence.</p>
