The methodology used is not clearly described and should be restructured. The results are interesting and important to researchers in relevant fields of agriculture, but for the publication of this study, I recommend supplementing it with other studies to support its importance and opportunity;</li> <li>- The purpose or goal of the work is within the journal's scope.</li> <li>- The number of references is limited and some corrections need to be made. I recommend the inclusion of a larger number of more recent studies on the subject and their insertion in bibliographic references.</li> </ul> <p>However, some corrections should be made in order to publish the article. Please, take into account the following recommendations to improve this manuscript:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The general presentation of the manuscript should be reviewed, the extra spaces between words or the lack of spaces between titles, subtitles and text according to the requirements of the journal;</li> <li>- I recommend a revision of the manuscript according to the requirements of the journal (English, technical editing, bibliography, etc.);</li> <li>- I recommend a critical approach to the literature to enable analysis and interpretation of the information, development of an objective viewpoint and the setting of clear objectives;</li> <li>- I recommend the inclusion of a larger number of more recent studies on the subject and their insertion in bibliographic references;</li> <li>- I recommend that conclusions be formulated highlighting the importance of the results presented;</li> <li>- <b>I recommend to approach and present at a higher scientific level the existing studies on this topic, as the scientific level of the manuscript is very low.</b></li> </ul> <p>Based on the above mentioned, I recommend this paper for publication after performing the suggested corrections.</p>
