

Editor's Comment:

After analyzing the article and the review suggestions made by the 2 reviewers, I point out the following issues that should be taken care of/corrected by the authors before publication:

1. The Abstract must be rewritten not exceeding 250 words and responding to the following items:
 - Summary framework (1 paragraph is sufficient) of presentation of the topic and justification of its importance / relevance
 - Objective of the article - Methodology used (literature review, integrative review.....) - Main results and conclusions

2. The point "1 – Introduction", should have bibliographical references that support its content.

3. There should be a chapter called "Methodology" with the presentation of the review method (sources consulted, descriptors used, exclusion/inclusion criteria, etc...) that was used for the preparation of the article.

4. A thorough review of language and syntax should be carried out.
