However, in addition to the comments on the body of the manuscript, the following remarks and suggestions can be mentioned:</p> <p><b>Introduction;</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.1. The introduction is somewhat lengthy and could benefit from more concise wording. Consider consolidating some sentences to improve readability.</li> <li>1.2. The introduction could benefit from a clear statement of the research objectives or questions to guide the reader's expectations.</li> </ol> <p><b>2. Material and Methods ;</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2.1. The section provides a clear description of the research design and methodology, including the population, sampling techniques, and data collection methods.</li> </ol> <p><b>3. Results an discussion ;</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3.1. The results and discussion section starts by outlining the research objective related to awareness of fire emergency preparedness among teachers and students, which provides a clear focus.</li> <li>3.2. The absence of tables and graphical representations, it is necessary to quantify the results in the form of statistical tables, graphs, given that the work presented is scientific and it is not literature.</li> <li>3.3. A native English speaker must reformulate the manuscript.</li> <li>3.4. The work requires major revision.</li> </ol> <p>Based on the content of the article, it appears to be a valuable contribution to the field of fire safety and education, particularly in the context of secondary schools in the Butiama District of Tanzania. The research findings provide insights into critical issues that need urgent attention, and the policy recommendations offer practical solutions to address these challenges.</p> <p>All these remarks do not detract from the scientific value of the article, and in conclusion, the article deserves to be published after taking into account the aforementioned observations and reservations.</p> <p>However, before publication, the article should undergo a thorough peer review process to ensure the rigor and validity of the research methodology, data analysis, and interpretation of findings. Additionally, the article should consider incorporating some of the suggested clarifications and elaborations in the policy recommendations section to provide guidance that is more practical to policymakers and educators.</p> <p>In conclusion, with these major revisions, this article has the potential to make a significant contribution to improving fire prevention in secondary schools and merits publication in the <b>Asian Journal of Education and Social Studies</b>.</p>
