Regarding investigations what was the relevance of rheumatoid factor, anti CCP-s Ab since the patient didn't have any joint involvement, why didn't you check her complement and feritin level (Still's disease could be also one differential diagnosis in such a case)                      - what do you mean by "the patient was given standard treatment"?                      - it would be nice to have some images (eg lymph nodes ultrasound and biopsy)</p> <p>Due to the short follow-up time, we cannot predict whether the patient will relapse or develop SLE but the discussion about KFD and SLE is important and actual, nevertheless authors should add references! By the way, all references should be updated (there are some new articles about HFD)</p>
