The manuscript provides a useful analysis of tuberculosis-related hepatotoxicity, including its mechanisms, risk factors, and management strategies.</p> <p>No! I suggest the title should be rephrased and made a single sentence. I recommend the following alternative titles:</p> <p>a) A Case Report of Fulminant Hepatitis Secondary to Anti-Tuberculosis Drug-Induced Hepatotoxicity Complication - its Prevention Strategies and Management'</p> <p>OR</p> <p>b) 'Fulminant Hepatitis Secondary to Anti-Tuberculosis Drug-Induced Hepatotoxicity Complication, its Prevention Strategies and Management: A Case Report.'</p> <p>OR</p> <p>c) 'Prevention and Management of Fulminant Hepatitis Secondary to Anti-Tuberculosis Drug-Induced Hepatotoxicity Complication: A Case Report.'</p> <p>The abstract of the article is comprehensive, however, it lacks patient's demographic details like sex/gender and treatment specifics. These should be updated. Also, spelling errors were spotted: "Fulminant Hepatitits" and "hapatotoxicity" should be corrected to "Fulminant Hepatitis" and "hepatotoxicity," respectively.</p> <p>Yes! However, it would be better structure if the 'case presentation' has subsections like "Diagnostic assessment" and "Therapeutic Interventions."</p> <p>Also, the author should declare whether or not patients' consent was required for this report, under a section for 'ethical consideration' at the end of the article.</p> <p>Yes! The manuscript is scientifically correct.</p> <p>The references are not sufficient in my assessment. The introduction and discussion section presented several statements that require citations for credibility. For instance, the introduction does not have any citations at all. Also, 58% of the references are not recent. Replacing them with more recent citations is recommended.</p>	
<p><u>Minor</u> REVISION comments</p> <p>1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</p>	<p>Yes! The language/English quality of the article is suitable for scholarly communications.</p>	

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<p><u>Optional/General</u> comments</p>	<p>TITLE The title should be rephrased.</p> <p>ABSTRACT The Case Presentation should be updated to include demographic details and treatment specifics.</p> <p>INTRODUCTION The referencing for this introduction is inadequate, and the details are too brief... A well referenced and robust introduction is required or necessary. The author should provide more context to the introduction and ensure adequate referencing. It could be improved by providing more specific context and significance related to the case report.</p> <p>CASE PRESENTATION Spelling errors, and typographical errors in units of measurement should be corrected. Also, creating subsections like 'diagnostic assessment' and 'therapeutic interventions' will improve the flow and clarity of the case presentation.</p> <p>DISCUSSION A number of spelling errors abound in the discussion section.</p> <p>"The national authorities consider the fight against tuberculosis a strategic priority. A program has been initiated to this effect for years."</p> <p>Considering the statement above, kindly estimate the number of years to give it a solid context. If possible, mention the specific program that was initiated for this purpose.</p> <p>The referencing is inadequate. For example, the following excerpts require citations:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. "However, the cost necessary for such a strategy would be significant to adopt it on a collective level. Treatment protocols requires a combination of several drugs and significant duration length. This reduces the risk of bacterial resistance but exposes to a high risk of toxicity. Hepatotoxicity can occur at any phase of treatment. Other liver damage affections can occur in treatment period like bacterial, viral or parasitic affections and medication exposure for other causes. The question of the benefit of the therapeutic protocol in relation to the risk of serious liver toxicity arises for less serious extrapulmonary forms such as pleural or lymph node tuberculosis."2. "During treatment period, the appearance of clinical signs or disturbances in liver biological tests requires a minimal initial assessment including: a history and a clinical examination looking for signs of alcoholism and cardiac liver disease; Aa liver ultrasound which helps to rule out tumor pathology, portal vein thrombosis or biliary obstruction, and. Viral serologies to rule out viral hepatitis."3. "Prevention of this complication involves informing patients who must recognize jaundice early, not trivialize the crude symptoms and encourage them to consult a physician as soon as possible." <p>Generally, the manuscript should be reviewed for spelling errors, improved clarity, and strengthening of the introduction and discussion sections, while ensuring adequacy and recency of relevant citations.</p>
