I will not suggest a title. The title is too vague, while the topic of the paper is more focussed. The abstract contains error, in fact the first sentence of the abstract is wrong. The abstract is also unclear, the sentences do not make sense in e.g. "(2)" Yes There are some problems. The first sentence of the paper is not-technical enough. The probability distribution statement is only true for some types of Kolmogorov complexity, and this has not been explained. No, there are missing recent reference. Most of the references are old, but people have discussed this topic in recent years, e.g. Hector Zenil, Paul Vitanyi, Kamaludin Dingle,... 	
<p>Minor REVISION comments</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications? 	It is quite good, but there are some sentences that do not make sence. Also it says "Let X and Y be two probability distributions over $\sum n$ " I do not know what this is supposed to mean.
