

### **Editor's Comment:**

Accepted after the revisions listed under

the article needs correction of the English language

-the Title should remain as it was in the original manuscript. The abbreviation can be used and explained the first time it appears in text.

-the References should not be written in full in the main text, only the corresponding number.

-the Introduction section contain two versions, I recommend keeping the first part of it (until the mention "OR")

-the section containing "Subjects and methods" (including criteria, excluding criteria, armamentarium also) should be included in the Methodology section

-page 15 – abbreviations like "1MM", "2MM" should be avoided- abbreviations should be explained the first time they appear in text

-the Results and discussion section: the Author should not provide both Table and Figure for the same dataset

-page 23 – the Author mentions CBCT and a reference from 1978 – was CBCT available at that time?

-the References are very, very old, the Author should replace them, and follow the recommended style of the journal for references. Also, the references should be numbered in the order of their appearance in text. And ALL the references from the "References" section should be mentioned in text.
