I will recommend to add case report to the title for example: Managment of Psychotic disorder during pregnancy: A case report Study. <p>???. The abstract gave a background about the case but was missing it's subheading; Aims, Presentation of Case, Discussion and Conclusion.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> As mentioned in number 3 abstract was missing it's subheadins and there was no acknowledgment sub heading. They need to mention some calrifications for the role of hydroxyzine and chlorpromazine in this case according to the guidelines? References are pretty old , I will recommend to search for recent references in the past 5 years.

Please avoid writing abbreviation unless you wrote the full words before in the manuscript Please clarify what is BDA, NLP's. IF CT was containdicated, was there any other radiological investigations instead as MRI included? This paragraph needs rephrasing "Injectable neuroleptics, which can cause changes in maternal blood pressure that can lead to fetal distress, and antiparkinsonian correctors, which increase atropine side-effects. It's common sense to prefer tablets to drinkable forms (which are widely used in psychiatry)" as I couldn't understand what it refers and means. You mentioned that the case was delerious, but what were the signs of delerium that she had, then you mentined that it was psychosis please provide clarification as this paragraph is not sufficient for diagnosis of delerium; it may refer to delusional symptom " The day after hospitalization: the patient was still unstable, wandering around the ward, sthenic, with a prosective delirium: "You're watching me, you're responsible for my condition", and aggressive towards staff. Injectable treatments were stopped and oral " What is the role of hydroxyzine in this case according to the guidelines? Citation of references in the text and acknowledgment are missing?
