This clarity aids in understanding the context and findings of the research. However, ensuring consistency in terminology and descriptions throughout the paper could further enhance coherence.</p> <p>Methodological Rigor: The utilization of a phenomenological approach for in-depth virtual interviews is appropriate for exploring the lived experiences of the Sama-Dilaut Tribe. This methodology allows for rich narratives and perspectives to be captured directly from the participants. However, it would be beneficial to elaborate more on the selection criteria for participants and the steps taken to ensure the validity and reliability of the data collected.</p> <p>Thematic Analysis: Thematic analysis is a suitable method for identifying key themes from qualitative data. The study appropriately employed this technique to extract significant findings regarding the economic activities and livelihood improvements of the Sama-Dilaut Tribe. Providing examples or quotations from the interviews to support the identified themes could strengthen the credibility of the analysis.</p> <p>Implications and Contribution: The study's findings have important implications for understanding the transition of marginalized communities towards entrepreneurship and economic empowerment. The conclusion effectively highlights the significance of community outreach and extension services in supporting indigenous peoples' socio-economic development. However, expanding on the specific policy recommendations or interventions that could further support the Sama-Dilaut Tribe and similar communities would add depth to the discussion.</p> <p>Limitations and Future Research: It would be valuable to acknowledge any limitations encountered during the research process, such as potential biases or constraints related to virtual interviews. Additionally, suggesting avenues for future research, such as longitudinal studies to track the long-term impacts of economic endeavors on the tribe's livelihood, could provide direction for further inquiry in this area.</p> <p>Overall, the study provides valuable insights into the economic activities and quality of life improvements among the Sama-Dilaut Tribe in Davao City. Strengthening the discussion with additional detail and addressing potential limitations would enhance the robustness and applicability of the research findings.</p>
