Yes, I think it is appropriate But, the meaning of several sentences is same in the introduction. In recent epidemiological studies, the incidence of first-episode pneumonia among unimmunized children in this age group has been reported at a staggering rate of 55.9 cases per 1000 person-years. This statistic underscores the pressing need for a thorough understanding of CAP in pediatric populations. (2) Moreover, regional disparities exist in the incidence and prevalence of pediatric CAP. For instance, in Canada, an estimated 41,000 children under the age of five experience non-hospitalized CAP annually, while approximately 9600 require hospitalization for more severe cases. (3) Recent epidemiological studies reveal a striking incidence rate of 55.9 cases per 1000 person-years among unimmunized children in this age bracket, highlighting the urgency for a comprehensive understanding of CAP within pediatric populations. (11) Notably, regional variations in CAP incidence and prevalence underscore the diverse impact of the disease across different geographical and healthcare contexts. In Canada, for instance, an estimated 41,000 children under five experience nonhospitalized CAP annually, with approximately 9600 requiring hospitalization for more severe cases.
