In general, the manuscript is scientifically accurate and well-presented, with clear methods and data. However, it would be helpful to provide more detailed explanations for certain results, particularly in terms of the reasons behind the effects of organic sources on crop yield and soil health. 6. The sources mentioned in the manuscript are appropriate and related to the topic. However, it would improve the credibility of the manuscript to include more recent references, especially those published within the last 5 years, to show current knowledge in the field.
