Yes, the manuscript is important for the scientific community. It addresses the significant social and economic impacts of male migration on left-behind women in a specific cultural context. 2. The current title, "Role of Male Migration in the Capability Expansion of the Left Behind Muslim Women in the Malappuram District of Kerala," is quite descriptive and relevant. However, for brevity and to enhance readability, an alternative title could be: Impact of Male Migration on the Empowerment of Left-Behind Muslim Women in Malappuram, Kerala 3. The abstract is comprehensive, detailing the research's context, objectives, methodology, and key findings. 4. The subsections and structure of the manuscript are appropriate. 5. Based on the provided excerpts, the manuscript appears scientifically correct. It utilizes established methodologies, such as the Capability approach and Ordinal Logistic Regression, to analyse the data. The findings are supported by statistical analysis, adding to the robustness of the conclusions. 6. Generally, ensuring that key references are within the last 5-10 years is ideal for maintaining the relevance of the study. It would be beneficial to include more recent research to support the findings. <p>Aspects should be improved:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Introduction should provide a clear research question or hypothesis early in the introduction. Ensure that the background information is concise and directly related to the study. 2. Include recent studies to demonstrate the relevance of the research. Clearly state how the current study fills a gap in the existing literature. 3. Discuss the implications of the findings for theory, practice, and future research. Address any limitations of the study and suggest areas for further investigation. 	
<p><u>Minor</u> REVISION comments</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications? 	<p>The grammar and syntax are generally sound.
