

Editor's Comment:

Overall, the manuscript has undergone slight changes as a result of the reviewers' recommendations with minor corrections at the author's discretion (including the title, methods, and few others). The recommendations themselves, for the most part, relate to technical and structural issues of the paper rather than those related to the content and methodology of the study itself.

There are still some repetitions that make the text more cumbersome but can be avoided with more careful paraphrasing, e.g. "Many qualitative researchers accept the criteria established by Lincoln and Guba (1985). These criteria include credibility, dependability, confirmability, and transferability. The researchers employed strategies suggested by Lincoln and Guba (1985) to increase the trustworthiness of the study's findings. These criteria include credibility, dependability, confirmability, and transferability" (p.11). Furthermore, a few sentences related to the limitations of the study would not be superfluous (there is such a recommendation).

I believe that the paper can be published after undergoing the above improvements.
