- The authors have not discussed their results in relation to other studies. This is a comment that was given by the reviewer and it does not seem to have been responded to.

Conclusions

- The conclusion seems to be a continuation of the results and discussion section. Authors should just provide the key take home message without discussing it.

The authors referencing system is not consisted. They have use both numbers and names within the text. They should revise this.
