The results can offer significant knowledge for both scholars and professionals in the domain of Islamic finance.</li> <li>2. The current title, "The Influence of Price Earning Ratio (PER) and Dividend on Sharia Stock Prices," is clear and directly reflects the content of the study. However, a more precise title could be: "Analyzing the Impact of Price Earnings Ratio and Dividend Yield on Sharia Stock Prices: Evidence from the Jakarta Islamic Index."</li> <li>3. The abstract provides a concise overview of the research objectives, approach, significant discoveries, and final conclusions. Nevertheless, enhancing the quality of the work could be achieved by establishing a more distinct structure and specifically indicating the statistical importance of the results. For example, explicitly provide the p-values in the results section of the abstract.</li> <li>4. The organisation and structure of the manuscript's subsections are generally suitable. The sections are arranged in a logical manner, commencing with the introduction, followed by the methodology, findings, and discussion.</li> <li>5. The manuscript appears to be scientifically correct, as it employs standard statistical methods and tests to analyze the data. The use of multiple linear regression and various statistical tests (normality, multicollinearity, heteroskedasticity, and autocorrelation) ensures the robustness of the findings. However, a deeper explanation of the statistical results and their implications would strengthen the scientific rigor.</li> <li>6. The references are generally sufficient and relevant, but it is important to ensure they are recent and comprehensive. Adding more recent studies (published within the last five years) on the relationship between financial ratios and stock prices, especially in the context of Islamic finance, would enhance the manuscript.</li> </ol> <p><b>Additional Suggestions/Comments:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.
