<p>Compulsory REVISION comments</p> <p>The structure of the manuscript is generally appropriate. However, some improvements could be made to improve clarity and flow.</p> <p>Suggestions for improvements:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The subsections "Soil Suitability" and "Agro-climatic conditions" should be further separated for clarity. For example, you could create subsections for temperature, rainfall, and humidity under the subsection "Agro-climatic conditions" to make it easier for readers to track specific factors.2. This section on nutrient requirements could be divided into two sections: a section on young trees and another section on mature trees. It should also be presented in a summary table, which would help clarify specific nutrient requirements based on the age of the trees.3. There should be a specific section on "Practical advice for farmers", which would allow for practical application of the research results, outlining key actions farmers need to take for successful cultivation.4. The "Conclusion" section should be expanded to include a discussion of broader implications, challenges, and possible future research directions.5. The section on harvesting and post-harvest handling could be more detailed, especially regarding the shelf life and processing of Kinnow.6. Old references should be replaced or supplemented with newer studies that provide updated information or research results on Kinnow cultivation and good practices in citrus cultivation.7. Some grammatical errors and inappropriate wording were found, which could be improved. A thorough review by the author or language proofreader by a native English speaker or professional editor would help eliminate these issues.8. Consider including tables, charts, or images to summarize key information.
