The manuscript could be improved by providing a more in-depth comparison between Konjac Glucomannan and other natural binders, which would help clarify its unique advantages. Additionally, the study's focus on a limited range of binder concentrations may limit the understanding of KGM's full potential across different formulations, leaving room for further exploration. Finally, more detailed statistical analysis of the results could strengthen the conclusions drawn about the binder's effectiveness.

The abstract could be improved by adding specific results, such as the performance of the 20% KGM concentration, to highlight the key findings more clearly. Additionally, it could benefit from a more concise background, allowing room for a brief mention of the quality control tests performed. Reducing general information about halal excipients would focus the abstract on the study's unique contributions.

While it follows standard testing methods, it doesn't include more detailed statistical analysis that could strengthen the findings. 2. The study only looks at a limited range of KGM concentrations, which means it might miss how the binder behaves in other scenarios. Plus, it doesn't compare KGM directly with other binders, making it hard to see if KGM is actually better or just another option. 3. These gaps could make the conclusions less convincing or broadly applicable.

No Comparison to Other Binders: It doesn't show how Konjac Glucomannan stacks up against other options, making it less useful. 3. Limited Concentration Range: Testing only a few binder concentrations restricts understanding of its full potential. 4. Language Issues: Poor grammar or unclear writing can make it hard to follow. Outdated References: Using old sources without newer research makes the study seem less relevant.
