Key areas such as the abstract, references, theoretical framework integration, and recommendations have been substantially enhanced. The author successfully incorporated the Resiliency Theory and Carl Rogers' Self-Actualization framework into the narrative, providing a stronger academic foundation. However, minor revisions are still recommended:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Language Refinement: Residual grammatical inconsistencies remain in the methodology section. For example:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>o Original: "The investigator defended the data collected from them and kept it secret and under wraps."</li><li>o Suggested: "The researcher ensured confidentiality and securely stored the collected data."</li></ul></li><li>2. Clarity in Results Presentation: While the individual case studies are detailed, emphasizing cross-case patterns in the "Results and Discussion" section could strengthen the analytical depth and broader implications.</li><li>3. Small Sample Size: Although justified in the context of qualitative research, its limitations should be explicitly reiterated in the conclusions to align expectations for generalizability.</li></ol>
