If not, the analyses should be repeated on the dry basis weight and then written in Table 2.  <b>Result and Discussion:</b>          The sequence of the samples in Table 2 should be written according to Table 1.          The explanation of the samples under Table 2. Should be deleted and moved to the end of the first paragraph of Material and Methods.          3.1 Moisture content: line 5, grammar mistake (was not a significant) correct is (was <b>no</b> a significant). Same mistake in the ash content, please correct it. Chane the (Table 3) in the Ash content to (Table 2), there is No Table 3!!
