Despite the severity of the problem, few studies have focused on the factors affecting the nutritional status of children in this age group in Kenya) -Specifically, the study sought to assess the socio-economic and demographic characteristics of caregivers -Anthropometric data were analyzed using ENA for SMART, and all other variables were processed using the Statistical Package for Social Sciences (SPSS) version 27. Descriptive statistics were used to outline the population characteristics, while regression analysis was employed to identify predictors of nutritional status, with a confidence interval of 95% and significance set at $p \leq 0.05$
