Sentence framing in section 2.2 second line is required. Section 3.6 is very vague, the section can add details like for those patients on long term PN with palliative care can report improved quality of life. Section 4.2 excessive glucose consumption can be corrected, it can be called glucose administration but not consumption.
