The relevance of this study is clear, as education access disparities, particularly among marginalized groups, remain significant barriers in India. By examining parental awareness and attitudes towards education, this study sheds light on various factors affecting educational progress within SC communities.

The current abstract provides a general overview of the study but could be enhanced by including specific details. We can add the following Context and Problem Statement: Briefly state the significance of addressing educational awareness among Scheduled Caste parents, especially in rural areas, to establish context. Methodology Details: The sampling technique and tools used for data collection should be briefly mentioned. Conclusion & Recommendations: The conclusion highlights the educational challenges faced by the SC community in general in India not specific to area under study. However, a summary of key findings, along with practical recommendations, would strengthen the conclusion's relevance.

There is a need for enhancing the data analysis, including in-depth recommendations, and revising the language. This will make it more suitable for publication. Currently, the study lacks the high standard of polish often expected in a high-quality academic journal . With improvements, the article would be a valuable contribution to the discourse on educational equity and parental awareness within SC communities in rural India.

While the article cites a few sources, referencing key government policies or programs aimed at SC educational upliftment could add depth and context, linking local findings to broader educational initiatives. Nothing is mentioned about status of education of SC in Assam from available data. Data

The article contains plenty of grammatical errors and typos that affect readability and need correction. For example, phrases like “Education improves social status, cultural and intellectual qualities...” could be refined to enhance clarity. Lots of refinement has to be done.
