<p>Optional/General comments</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is now clear explanation about choosing the methodology, why both of them and which one happened first, or was it parallel? <i>“The research method used is development research with a quantitative and qualitative approach. Data was collected through tests, classroom observations, and interviews with students and lecturers involved”.</i> • There is no information about the questionnaire and the way of data collection such as number of participants and how the data is calculated. Which technique was used and what were the questions? • What kind of questions were asked in the interview and there is no sample of them <i>“ Data collection was also carried out through observation and interviews with lecturers and students at several universities that have implemented the Release Model in reading and writing learning.”</i> No information about interviewing setting and data analysis. • Punctuation error“ more innovative learning that can stimulate students' active involvement in the learning process and develop their critical thinking skills.” • This sentence needs to be supported scholarly who said it <i>“The Release Model has the potential to change the paradigm of reading and writing learning in universities, from passive learning to learning that prioritizes active student involvement.”</i> • Inconsistency in the narration of methodology, which one was used finally, QUAN, QUAL OR BOTH, <i>“ This research aims to develop and implement the Release Model as an alternative reading and writing learning model in higher education that can improve students' critical literacy. Using qualitative research methods, this study will observe the effectiveness of the Release Model in developing students' critical thinking skills, as well as see its impact on students' ability to read and write in a more reflective and analytical way.”</i> • What are the criteria for choosing the literature studies as mentioned in the text: <i>“The researcher collected data from various literature relevant to the development of a learning model based on critical literacy and inquiry approaches. The literature studied includes books, journal articles, and previous research that discusses critical literacy and inquiry learning.”</i> It needs to be written in a clear manner. • Result section needs to be rewritten in a supportive way it is just descriptive and no information about data analysis and interpretation is presented. • How and why ?<i>“To support wider implementation, it is recommended that lecturers be provided with training in the application of this model, especially in the aspect of developing students' critical inquiry skills. In addition, curriculum adjustments that provide more room for inquiry-based approaches also need to be considered so that this model can be applied optimally without excessive time pressure.”</i>
