It provides new insights into how intellectual stimulation influences teaching practices and the overall school environment. The study enriches existing literature by focusing on an underexplored context, specifically in the Philippines, and highlights factors that enhance teacher motivation and school productivity.

(If not please suggest an alternative title)	The title "Intellectual Inspiration and Productive School Culture Among Public Elementary School Teachers in Marilog District" is appropriate as it clearly reflects the focus of the study on the relationship between intellectual inspiration and school culture among teachers in a specific location.

The abstract is generally comprehensive, but a few improvements can be made. First, it would be beneficial to clarify the geographical and educational context by emphasizing the importance of studying this topic in the Philippines, particularly in the Marilog District. Additionally, the key findings could be more clearly stated, particularly the relationship between intellectual inspiration and productive school culture. Including practical implications for school leaders, such as how these findings can improve the school environment, would also strengthen the abstract.	
Is the manuscript scientifically, correct? Please write here.	The manuscript is scientifically correct. It uses an appropriate research design, valid statistical methods, and a well-described sampling approach. The instrument was tested for reliability, and the study follows a systematic process, ensuring accurate and credible results.

The references are comprehensive and scientifically valid, but adding more recent studies on intellectual inspiration and productive school culture in elementary education would strengthen the manuscript. Including sources related to socio-cultural influences in similar educational contexts, such as the Philippines, would also enhance its relevance.

Is the language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?	The language of the manuscript is generally clear, but several improvements can enhance clarity and readability. First, simplifying complex sentences would improve flow. For example, the sentence on quantitative research can be shortened to: "Quantitative research collects and analyzes numerical data to identify patterns, make predictions, and test relationships, which can be generalized to larger populations." Additionally, restructuring long sentences for conciseness, such as revising "The study was conducted during the 2022–2023 school year, with 133 teachers participating, selected through universal sampling," to "The study, conducted during the 2022–2023 school year, included 133 teachers selected through universal sampling," will improve readability.	
Optional/General comments	To improve the manuscript, I suggest clarifying the practical implications of the study's findings, particularly how they can be applied by educators and school leaders to enhance school culture and foster intellectual inspiration.
