Please provide clear definitions or explanations for these terms (see yellow marked words).</p> <p>b) Under 'Reliability Test':</p> <p>(1) Please review and correct spelling errors identified in the yellow marked words. Accuracy in language is crucial for maintaining the credibility of the study.</p> <p>(2) There is a discrepancy between the table number in the table caption and the one mentioned in the description. Ensure that the table numbers are consistent throughout the document.</p> <p>c) Suggestion:</p> <p>Consider inserting measurement items under each construct (for welfare, sale, income, and labor) in separate tables. This organization will enhance clarity and facilitate a more detailed examination of the relationships between items and constructs.</p> <p>d) Reference:</p> <p>A thorough review of the references is necessary. Almost 90% of the references either do not match or are not found in the text citations. Please cross-verify and correct all discrepancies between the reference list and in-text citations.
