However, it falls short in clearly stating how the findings contribute to existing scientific knowledge. The authors should explicitly highlight the novel aspects and implications of their study for the scientific community.</p> <p>The title is relevant and suitable but could be more specific and concise. Consider a title like Assessing the impact of Grameen Bank Credit on Welfare: A Case Study of PT. Permodalan Nasional Madani in Indonesia.</p> <p>The abstract is quite brief and lacks details on research methods, key findings, and implications. It should be expanded to include these elements, making it more comprehensive for readers seeking a quick overview of the study.</p> <p>The manuscript structure is generally appropriate, but there is room for improvement in organizing the content more logically. Consider revising the flow of information in some sections for better coherence. Additionally, provide clear transitions between subsections.</p> <p>The manuscript appears scientifically sound, but certain claims, especially those related to the impact of Grameen Bank patterns on welfare, need more concrete evidence or statistical backing. Ensure that the methodology and results sections provide robust support for the conclusions drawn.</p> <p>The references are relevant, but there is a need for more recent sources to strengthen the literature review. Include recent studies on Grameen Bank patterns and their impact on welfare. Suggest exploring publications from the last five years to ensure the content reflects current scholarship.</p>	
<p>Minor REVISION comments</p> <p>1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</p>	<p>The language quality is generally suitable for scholarly communication. However, some sentences are complex and may benefit from simplification for better clarity. Proofread for grammatical errors and ensure a consistent academic tone throughout.</p>
