<p>Optional/General comments</p>	<p>The conclusion stating no significant influence with a call for further studies seems underwhelming and could be strengthened by exploring possible explanations for the findings.</p> <p>The significant association between the 40-49 age group and local medication use deserves further exploration and discussion in the context of accelerated orthodontics.</p> <p>The method of data collection (convenience sampling) may not guarantee a representative sample of all Nigerian dental practitioners.</p> <p>It is unclear how diverse the demographics were in terms of gender, years of experience, specialty, and location, which could impact the generalizability of the findings.</p> <p>Suggestions for improvement:</p> <p>Discuss the potential reasons for the lack of significant associations between demographics and perception. Could it be due to cultural factors, lack of awareness, or specific concerns unrelated to demographics?</p> <p>Delve deeper into the significant association between the 40-49 age group and local medication use. This could provide valuable insights into the specific concerns held by this age group regarding accelerated orthodontics.</p> <p>Acknowledge the limitations of the sampling method and discuss its potential impact on the results.</p>	

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	<p>Provide more details on the participant demographics to allow for a better understanding of the sample and the generalizability of the findings.</p> <p>Consider alternative data collection methods, such as stratified random sampling, to ensure a more representative sample of the Nigerian dental practitioner population.</p>
