My suggestions would be as follows:</p> <p>1) Please mention whether carnoy's solution or modified carnoy's solution was used for chemical cauterization and if peripheral ostectomy was done with enucleation.</p> <p>2) Second suggestion would be to check if the preoperative radiograph displays any associated pathology (if available with the mentioned practitioner). If preoperative radiograph was not taken then this paper highlights this requirement. Even for simple dental extraction a thorough clinical exam and basic IOPA would prevent such delays in appropriate treatment delivery. If this can be mentioned as a takeaway message of this report it would be beneficial for all practitioners to understand the value of following correct preoperative protocol. Image of OPG taken before enucleation would be beneficial if added to the report.</p> <p>Otherwise manuscript is concise and informative, scientifically correct with adequate references and beneficial for the dental community.</p>
