The revised manuscript needs revision before it could be considered for publication.

Manuscript title: Assessment of different varieties of okra for yield, quality and economical feasibility cultivated under Hadoti region of South-East Rajasthan

In this revised manuscript, the authors have considered the changes suggested by the reviewers and revised the manuscript accordingly. Nevertheless, after going through the manuscript, I have certain comments and suggestions that need addressal before the manuscript can be considered for publication.

- Modify the title as suggested in the annotated manuscript.
- I find references not cited for most of the information provided in the introduction. It is important to duly acknowledge the sources of information when it is not one's own. Therefore cite suitable references for the information provided in the introduction section.
- Revise the methods section by providing additional details. Provide details on the cultural practices (irrigation, weeding, pesticide application, etc.) adopted during the study period.
- Generally, the price of any vegetable tends to fluctuate with space and time. Therefore clarify how the sale price of okra was fixed at Rs. 25/kg for calculating economic feasibility.
- It is important to explain all the procedures used in the study. However, I find no mention of the statistical analysis used in the study.
- From the results, I understand that ANOVA was used to assess the significance of variation. If so mention the type of ANOVA (one-way, two-way, etc.) and whether the data were checked for homogeneity before statistical analysis.
- Delete the column treatment in all the tables as the varietal codes are not used in the presentation. Similarly, Tables 1–4 present the results of the Post Hoc analysis (mark the

means that are different with alphabets).
