An example of this is that there are still references that only have the authors' names and the year:

- Muraya, M. W., Ngari, L.K., &Gathungu, G.K. (2020)
- Mwangome M, Ngari M, Bwahere P, Kabore P, McGrath M, Kerac M, et al. (2019)

I suggest that authors consult a guideline for the correct preparation of references, for instance:

Therefore, if this aspect is corrected, I have nothing to oppose the publication of the article.
