<p>1. Authors should review the abstract, which is very extensive. The abstract should not exceed more than 250-300 words. In this case, they should reduce the 1st part of the framework and the results should be only the main ones.</p> <p>2. There is information that for an article should not be included, for example, putting the sample calculation formula. Only its bibliographical reference should be cited.</p> <p>3. On the other hand, there are important chapters in an article, which in this case are very little developed, such as the Conclusion.</p> <p>4. In the Results chapter, the results tables should be integrated with the descriptive text and not separated sequentially at the end of the text.</p> <p>5. It is not clear why Figure 1 appears at the end of the discussion chapter.</p> <p>6.
