

Editor's Comment:

Following a detailed evaluation of all documents related to the manuscript, I have to STOP the process of publishing the manuscript.

Although both two reviewers had only minor suggestions for the text, the authors ignored all of them, and no corrections were introduced to the text. Moreover, the authors wrote untruthfully in response to reviews, claiming that the corrections had been made. The only change in the revised manuscript is a few yellow highlights of random fragments in the text. Nothing more!

Also, the request of the editorial team was ignored.

Authors should treat the work of the editorial team, reviewers, and editors with greater respect. Authors should make corrections following the reviewers' comments, and if they do not agree with them, they should justify their objection. But what is most unacceptable is misleading the editors by lying in the answers and randomly selecting text.

My decision is: return to the authors for proper correction!
