Recent references are required</p> <p>In the title itself the name of the drug used is incorrect- it should be Streptozotocin instead of streptozotocin</p> <p>The introduction part should be a bit more informative and should include a short review about the parts of coriander used, its different pharmacologically activities and the phytoconstituents present.</p>	Okay
