These need to be check prior to publication. 5. Yes 6. There is a problem in formatting in reference. I have mentioned it in the comment section. 	
<p>Minor REVISION comments</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications? 	NO NOT AT ALL	
<p>Optional/General comments</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Instead of writing some polyphenols in the title, please specify the class of polyphenols. 2. First sentence of the introduction should not start with "It is known that oxidative.....". Please reconstruct the line and make it precise. 3. Most of the sentences in Introduction are written as "it has shown/ it is noted/....". Instead of using "it" specify the sample/specimen/observation. It is very confusing. 4. In Material Method section, the first sentence starts as Theses polyphenols... Please specify. 5. There is lot of grammatical/typological error in the manuscript. Go through the entire manuscript thoroughly and do the necessary changes. Change the term "pathologies". 6. The work is well-executed, but there is serious problem in sentence construction. Most of the sentences are complex and do not impart any meaning. Majority of the sentences in all sections (Introduction, Result and Discussion, Conclusion) starts with it has been shown/it is noted. REFRAME AND AVOID USING "IT" REPEATATIVELY. Please check carefully and substantially. 7. Add acknowledgement, funding, and conflict of interest. 8. Reference should be in alphabetical order and properly written.
