However, I recommend incorporating specific findings related to cilnidipine's efficacy and safety as highlighted in the results section.</li> <li>The subsections and structure of the manuscript are found to be appropriate.</li> <li>The manuscript is considered scientifically correct. However, the reviewer suggests providing more clarity on certain points, such as the comorbid conditions and the rationale for the selection of cilnidipine.</li> <li>The references are deemed sufficient and recent.
