The lack of knowledge about certain infectious diseases and their preventive measures represents one of the major causes of the relatively high prevalence of such conditions in certain communities.</p> <p>Yes, but the term ophthalmology "clinic" is more academic than "eye clinic".</p> <p>yes</p> <p>yes, but in all references, it is written as "hepatitis B" not hepatitis b".</p> <p>There is only a single crucial note that requires clarification. HBV vaccine is usually given during the 1<sup>st</sup> 6 months of life, so how can we rely on the answers of the participants who answer with "no" about the inquiry about HBV vaccine. Most of them might have already vaccinated during the early period of life but they are unaware about their vaccination status. Nothing has been mentioned about this issue although it might affect the results.</p> <p>References are sufficient</p>
