

### **Editor's Comment:**

Unfortunately in my opinion the paper should not be published in Journal of Advances in Microbiology in actual form.

The Authors included only a few of reviewer's comments in the revised version 1 of the manuscript. There are still many grammar and spelling mistakes, paragraph gaps, wrong punctuations - it regards especially presenting the data, for example: instead of 720, 6µm it should be used 720.6 µm, instead of 25 0C it should be used 25°C,

instead of 3±0,91cm it should be used 3.0±0.91 cm, etc.

Special characters like italics are still not used uniformly for scientific names.

Figure 3A-F has very low technical quality – it should be improved.

The statistical analysis is not performed properly.

Analysis of variance (ANOVA) should be followed by post-hoc tests.

The statement  $P=05$  is not proper as it does not present statistical significance. One should use  $P<0.05$  in case of statistical significance or  $P>0.05$  in case of lack of statistical significance – it must be corrected in all places where the statistical significance is presented.

In my figures the error bars are not presented in uniform style - some of them are one-sided and the others are two-sided – it should be corrected

The declaration regarding "Availability of data and materials" should be included instead of the statement "

A copy of the written consent is available for review by the Editorial office/Chief Editor/Editorial Board members of this journal"

The references are really old – less than half of them were published in last 10 years and only 5 were published in last 5 years – some more recent references should be included.

The references are not presented in uniform style – there are lacking some bibliographic data (volume, issue, pages), some journal titles are written as full names and others as abbreviations, some last pages are presented as full number and others are abbreviated, etc.

The reference [29] is not included in the text of the manuscript.
