

Editor's Comment:

Although it was stated in the introduction of the study that model estimation would be performed using the Panel OLS technique, the empirical part of the study presented results from fixed effects models. Furthermore, both OLS and Fixed Effect estimation models may be used in this study. If a test was conducted to determine which model was superior, a conclusion could be reached. It is noteworthy that this conclusion is in agreement with the findings of the reviewer named Bisiriyu Sodiq Olaide. Consequently, it is not appropriate to publish the study without making major revisions in accordance with this reviewer's requests. The abstract section still states that the OLS model will be used, even though it is stated that the Reviewer's requests have been corrected.

Additionally, the study still includes the results of the Fixed effect model. There is a difference between the method aimed at in the study and the method employed in the study. It is imperative that this important bug be corrected. It is not appropriate to publish the study in its current state.
