Was it all just from reading and subjective interpretation of what is currently happening?</p> <p>It is not clear on what type of manuscript article is this, but the sections and structure of an article must be reviewed.</p> <p>It is recommended to follow the structure and sections of a research article to present an unbiased and evidence-based accounts.</p> <p>It is suggested to follow a specific style and format in writing reference and in-text citation. May add References with studies and findings that are relevant to the topic.</p>	
<p>Minor REVISION comments</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications? 	<p>It is suggested to revisit the flow of the article. To create a smooth story-telling of the article.</p>
