I need more information. The palpitation was symptom of 72% of cases and others with dizziness or syncope that is in contrast with the title. Authors didn't mention about patients with a history of documented arrhythmias, or a history of or the current use of anti-arrhythmic drugs excluded or not. The Holter is for patients with unexplained palpitation so those with basic ECG with known arrhythmia should be excluded. The echo data should be in more details especially in patient with cardiomyopathies and history of IHD. Specify what is the valvular disease and severity. Please explain patients with what kind of congenital heart disease and structural heart disease. Specify VT is sustained or not. The sample size is small. It was better to split sample size to patients without any history of disease that are associated with cardiac arrhythmia and other one. To signify the importance of Holter in patients with underlying cardiac disease or cardiovascular risk factors in correlation with patients with negative medical history. About the PVCs, are there any couplet, bigeminy or ...
